



Namibia Open Learning Network (NOLNet) eLC, on behalf of InWEnt, would like to invite all interested partners in East Africa (Kenya, Uganda, Tanzania, Rwanda and Burundi) to nominate participants for the following regional eLearning Courses in 2008:

- eLIP (eLearning in Practice)
- eLDI (eLearning Development and Implementation)

eLIP

This course is designed for people who would like to specialise in a particular area of eLearning i.e. eLearning Manager, Instructional Designer, eLearning course Producer or eLearning Facilitator. eLIP consists of 4 online courses:

- Management in Practice (MiP),
- Instructional Design in Practice (IDiP),
- Content Development in Practice (CDiP) and
- Tutoring in Practice (TiP),

Each module runs for 3 weeks online, with two face-to-face workshops. Workshop 1 is the start up and runs for two (2) days and workshop 2 is the concluding one, running for four (4) days. After the eLIP Course there will be further online support for participants in the afore-mentioned areas of specialization.

The application form for the eLIP Course for 2008 is attached and must be filled out by all recommended participants by institutions or interested individuals. As the training slots are extremely limited, applications will be on first come first served basis.

There is a **course fee of €200** for participation in an eLIP Course, unless institutions or individuals can provide valid reasons for NOT being able to afford the €200 in which case such an individual or institution can apply for an InWEnt scholarship for exemption of course fees. (See Scholarship Application From as part of Application Form). Mode for payment is specified in the application form.

COURSE SCHEDULE

Start up workshop: 14-15 April 2008,

Workshop venue: UNEP Headquarters, Nairobi, KENYA

Deadline for applications is 1st April 2008.

eLDI

This is a much longer and detailed course with specific relevance to eLearning Managers who would like to get a holistic idea of all eLearning aspects ranging from Instructional Design (ID), Content Development (CD), eLearning Technology (eLT), Interactivity (INT), Tutoring and Support of Virtual Learning Communities (VLC) and eLearning Management (eLM).

COURSE SCHEDULE

The course starts with a five (5) day face-to-face workshop and continues with a six (6) month online phase and then concludes with a seven (7) day face-to-face workshop. Please read more on the requirements for course participation and a more detailed description of the course in the attached document called **eLDI Information**.

eLDI 2008 start-up workshop will be on **21-25 May 2008 in Accra Ghana** Note that places are limited and there are only 15 slots for East and South Africa.

Deadline for applications for eLDI is **04** April **2008**.

Overall course fee for eLDI is €600.00. Institutions and individuals can apply for exemption of course fees using the scholarship application form as part of the eLDI Application Form. Mode of payment specified in application form..
