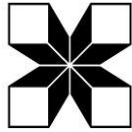

2. **Background and Significance:** Present the background to the project and include a critical evaluation of existing knowledge. Explain how this project advances existing knowledge and describe how the research corresponds to IDRC's Acacia thematic areas and/or the specific country's needs and priorities. Describe the policy relevance of your research project (3 pages).
3. **Research Design and Methods:** Describe the project design and the procedures to be used to accomplish the specific aims of the project; both qualitative and

quantitative. Elaborate on any ethical or gender considerations (Maximum 6 pages).

4. **References:** Provide a list of all references.
5. **Budget:** Specific items may include field research, a monthly stipend for up to 12 months and other research materials (e.g. laptop, specialized software or books etc).
6. **Timeline to Completion:** Provide a detailed plan for completing the dissertation within a period not longer than 24 months after the award.
