





Call for Participation: IT&ITES SMEs and start-ups

The International Trade Centre, the joint agency of the World Trade Organization and the United Nations, is inviting companies in Kenya's IT & ITES sector to apply to participate in a project of the Netherlands Trust Fund (NTF) III programme, focusing on enhancing export competitiveness in the IT & ITES sector. The project is a three-year initiative that will provide in-depth capacity building and market-penetration support to 33 start-ups, as well as local exporting and export-ready companies. The project is specifically designed to enhance the capacity, competitiveness and exports of small and medium-sized enterprises.

The project will:

- Provide training and advisory services on topics such as export marketing and access to finance; and
- Facilitatebusiness-to-businessevents in Europe and Africa between international buyers and Kenyan companies.
